### PHOTO CONTEST

Are you an avid lover of nature? Do you like capturing the beauty of nature in photos? If you answered yes to these questions, you should submit a photo to the Gathering Partners of Natural Resources Conference photo contest! This contest is open to photographers of all skill levels and up to 3 submissions per photographer can be entered. All photos must be taken in Minnesota.

There are six categories that you may enter photographs in:

- **Plants** photographs of terrestrial and aquatic plants that photosynthesize and grow here in Minnesota
- **Wildlife** photographs of animals (i.e. birds, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, fish) that live in Minnesota during all or a portion of their life.
- **Scenery** photographs of landscapes and beautiful scenes (e.g. rainbow over lake superior, sunset along the Mississippi River bluffs, etc) within Minnesota
- **Projects/Play** photographs depicting people playing or working in Minnesota's natural environment.
- Macro photographs of small items larger than life size (e.g. a zoomed in photo of an insect)
- **Digitally Enhanced** photography that is abstract and edited using Photoshop, paintbrush, etc.

Bring your 8x10 printed photo(s) with matboard(s) to the conference registration desk by Saturday at noon. All entries must be original work of a conference participant. Photographs can be color or black and white. You must submit a photo contest entry form with your photo which will be provided at the conference registration desk. Staff will hang the photos up in the designated area under the categories indicated on the form. All conference participants will be able to vote for their favorite photo for each of the categories. Popular vote wins! Winners for each category will be announced during lunch on Sunday, May 22nd.
